Analysis from 2021-22 Student Satisfaction Survey

1. 96% of the respondents have confirmed that more than 70% of the syllabus has been covered in class. Out of this around 76% have indicated that across all subjects 80% to 100% of the syllabus has been taught by the faculty.
2. Almost 100% of the respondents were well satisfied by the teachers' preparedness for the classroom.
3. 70% of the respondents found the teachers' communication skills to be effective and comprehensible.
4. Around 83% indicated that the teaching methodology was above par while around 14% were quite satisfied with the faculty's approach to teaching. More than 90% indicated that in fact teachers illustrate different concepts through examples and applications to make learning easy. They further noted that student centric techniques like experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies were often employed to enhance the learning experience.
5. Around 94% were satisfied with the internal evaluation system of the college.
6. Above 80%, further noted that feedback was given by the teacher regarding their individual performances in the different assignments that had been allotted to them. They also noted that teachers informed them about their competencies and what they can expect from the courses/ programs they have opted for. Further, the faculty mentors them to identify their weaknesses and provide suggestions as to how they can overcome them.
7. 44% of the respondents indicated that internships, student exchange and field visits were

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- regularly organized by the college while 28% said that such activities were often held.
8. Though 87% of the respondents concurred that the institution provides adequate opportunities to learn and grow, 78% felt that teaching and mentoring process facilitates their cognitive, social and emotional growth significantly, and 17% said that their cognitive, social and emotional growth have been moderately satisfactory.
 9. 83% of the respondents indicated that a 360-degree appraisal system was followed by the institution so that the students can give their feedback and reviews for the continuous improvement of the teaching-learning process.
 10. A sizable percentage of the respondents (approximately 80%) indicated that the institution undertakes great effort to inculcate life skills, soft skills and employability skills of its students. The students are greatly encouraged to participate in various extracurricular activities that help them showcase their inherent talents and make them ready for life after academics.
 11. 85% of the respondents said that more than 70% of the faculty use ICT tools while teaching.
 12. 90% of the respondents agreed that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institution was well satisfactory.

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
