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ANALYSIS OF 2022-23 STUDENT FEEDBACK

1. Student feedback indicates that more than 90% of students find the following to be satisfactory:
 - a. Teachers are regular and punctual in class (94% of students believe)
 - b. The classroom facilities are good. (95% of respondents said)
 - c. The overall quality of the college regarding the Teaching-Learning process, Infrastructure and student support services is good. (93% of students remarked)
 - d. 94% of respondents agreed that the safety and security of students have been ensured by the college.
2. Syllabus coverage as prescribed by the University of Calcutta, library facilities, technological support, and student-teacher relationships have been found to be quite adequate by above 90% of the respondents.
3. 93% felt that the overall learning environment in the college is good.
4. 90% of the respondents found the Laboratories are equipped with the latest apparatus and properly maintained.
5. 91% of the respondents felt that Technological support (use of teaching aids, models, PPT, films, etc.) is optimal.
6. Almost 92% of respondents found Sports and Canteen infrastructure are good.
7. 92% stated that the number of value-added courses available would increase their chance of employability.
8. 94% of the respondents felt that College gives Importance to co-curricular and extracurricular activities. But around 6% of students (respondents) indicated that the extracurricular activities were not adequate.
9. 90% of respondents found the college's administrative offices are efficient and student friendly.
10. 92% of students find the college washrooms are clean and well-maintained.

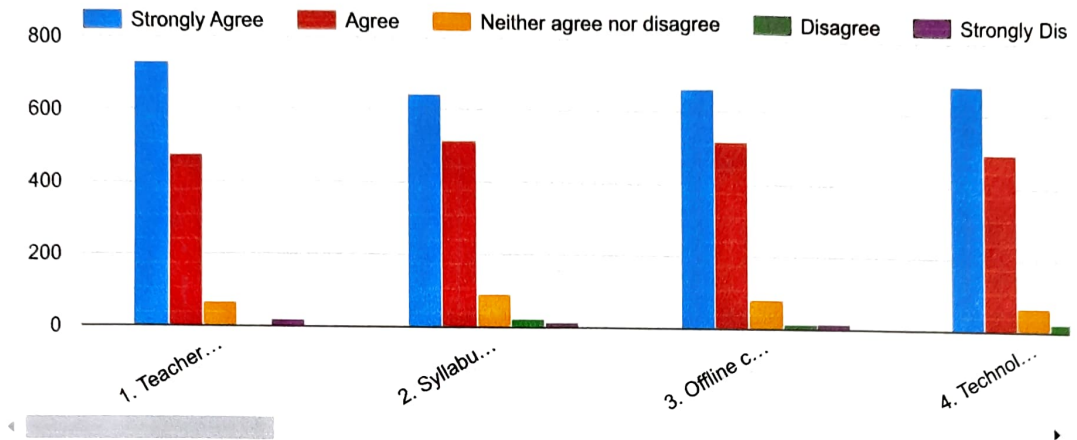

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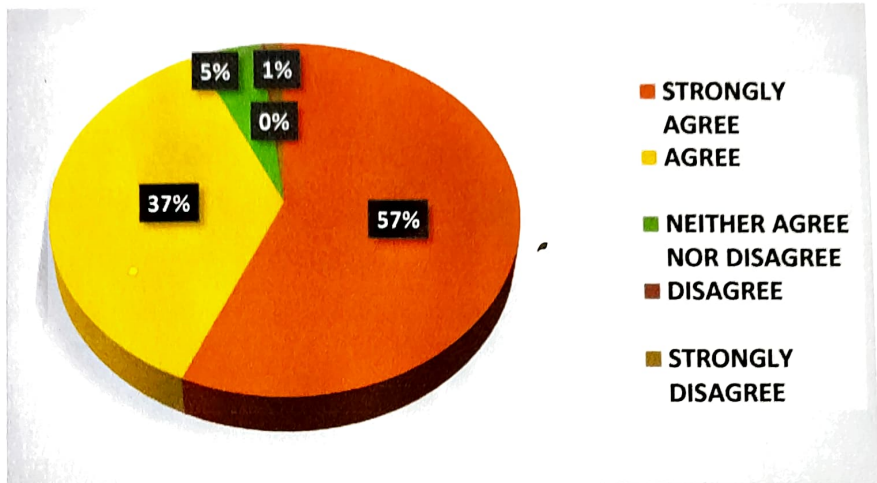

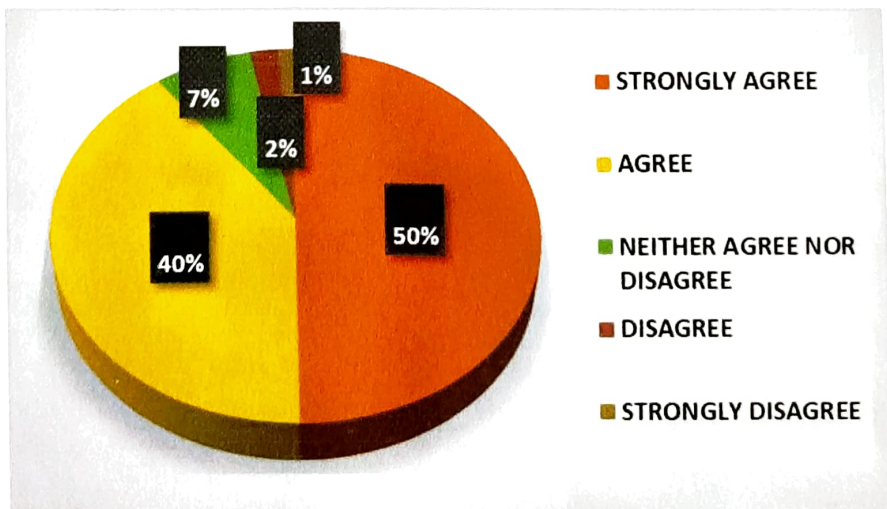
1. Teachers are regular and punctual in class.

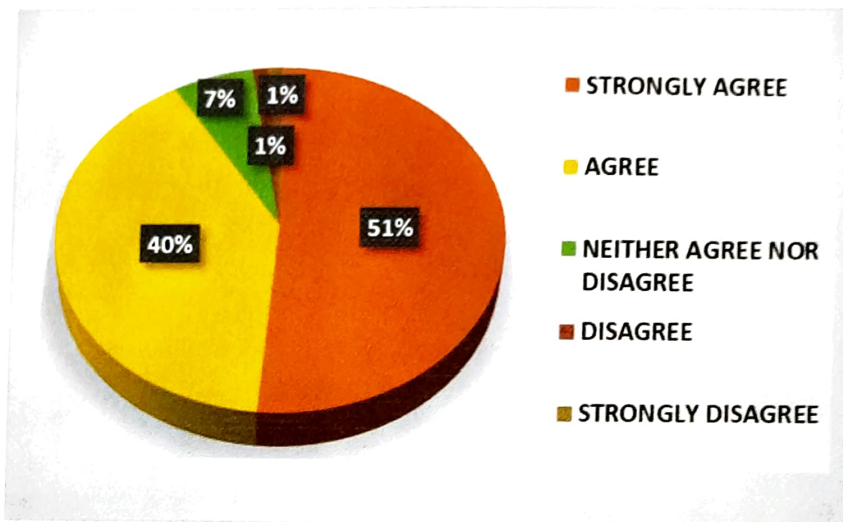
2. Syllabus Coverage as prescribed by the University is adequate.

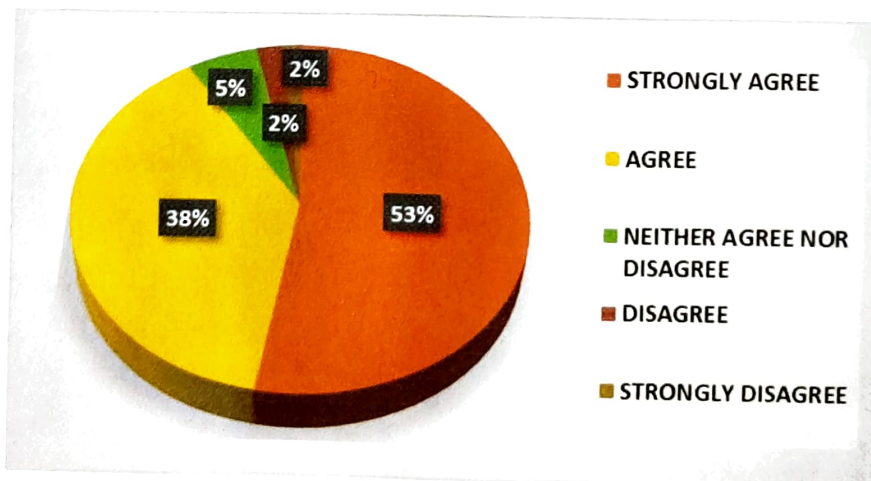
3. Offline class delivery was adequate.

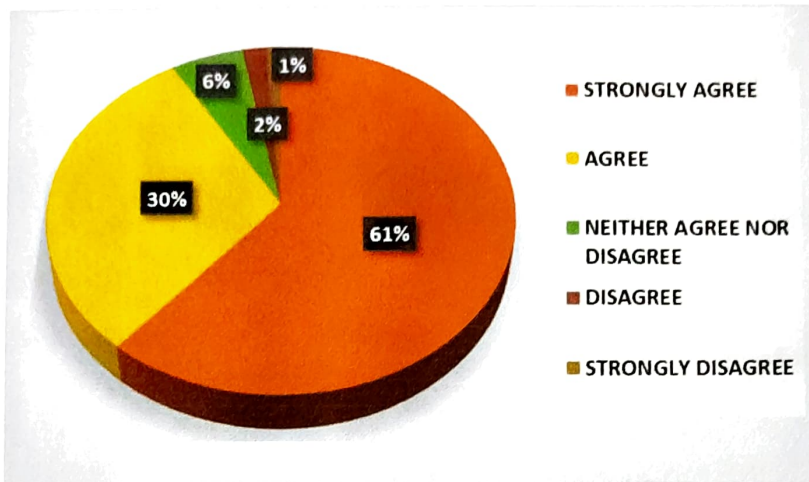

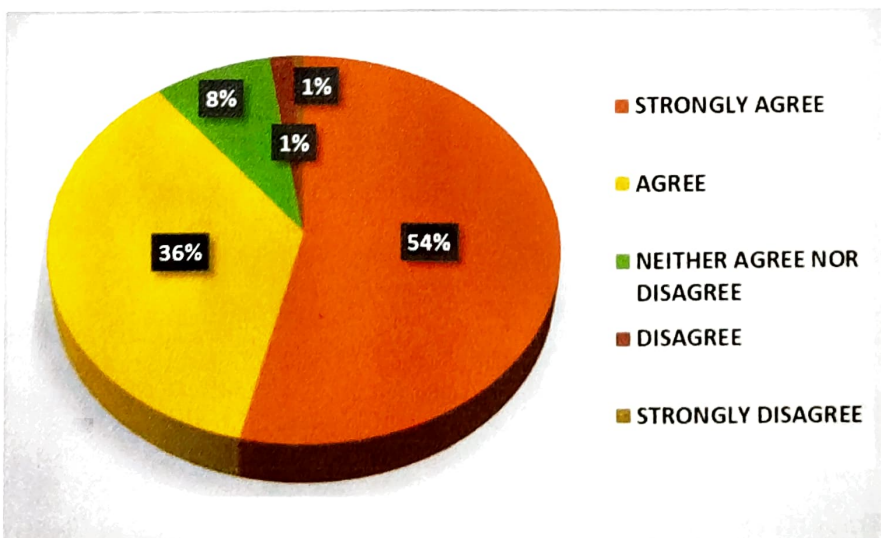
5. Library facilities are adequate.

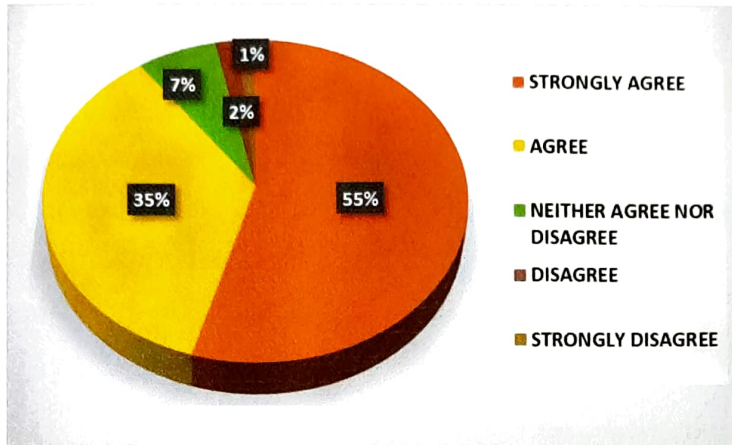
6. Laboratories are equipped with latest apparatus and properly maintained.

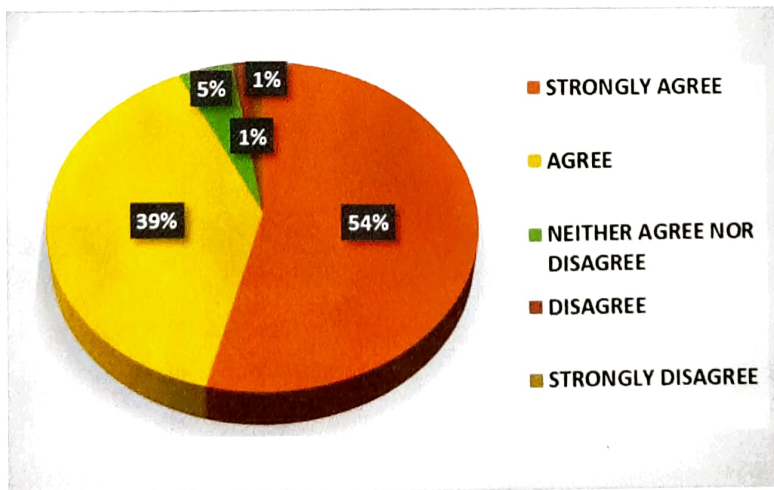
7. Student-teacher relationship in your department is satisfactory.

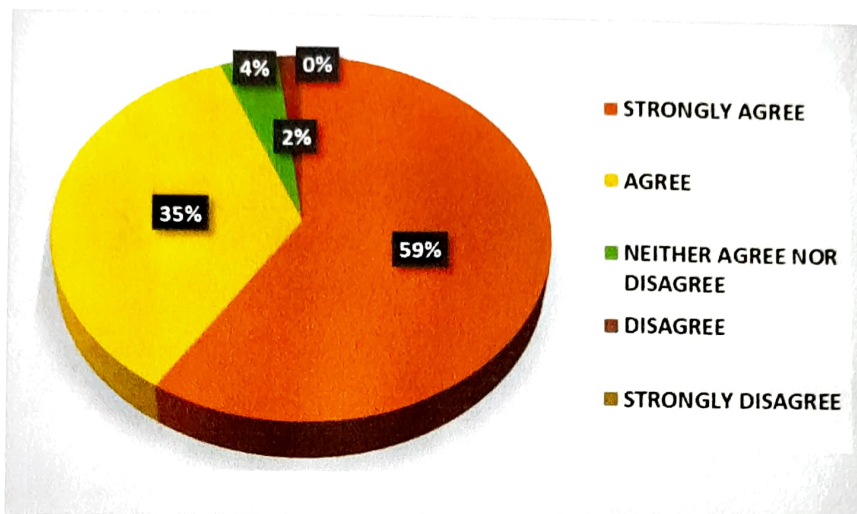
8. Overall learning environment is good

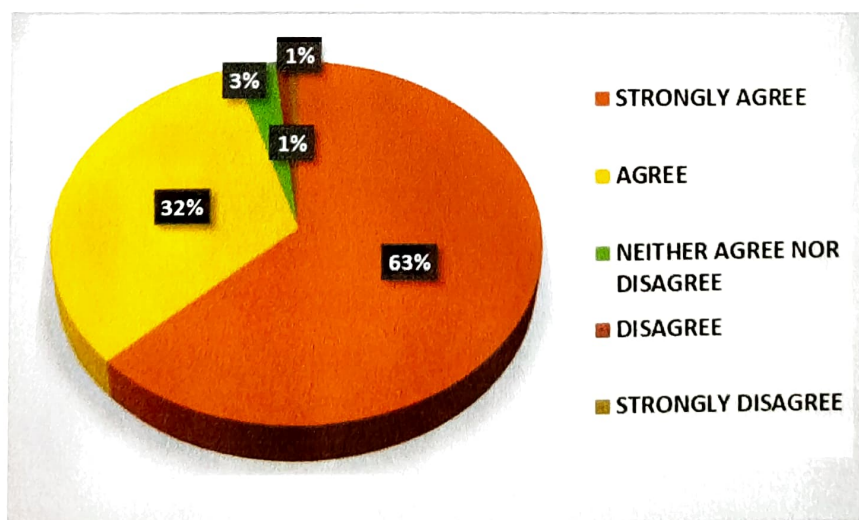
9. You feel you are in a safe and secure environment in college

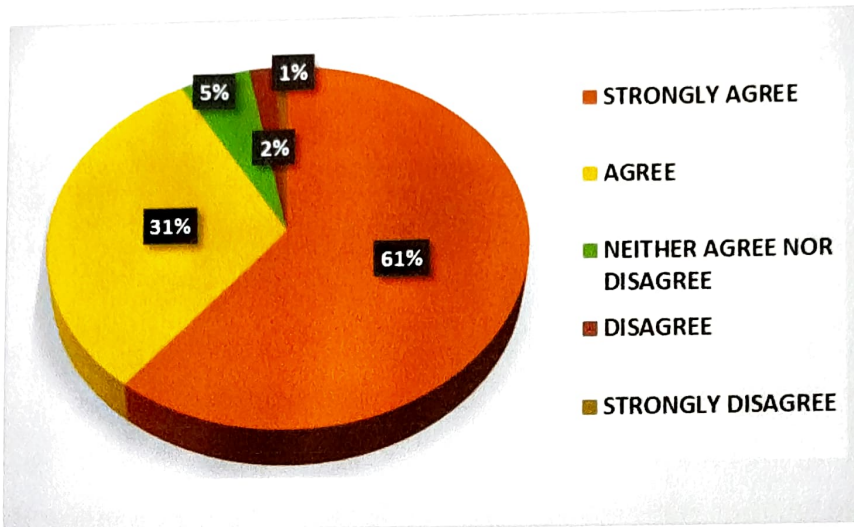
10. Classroom facilities are good.

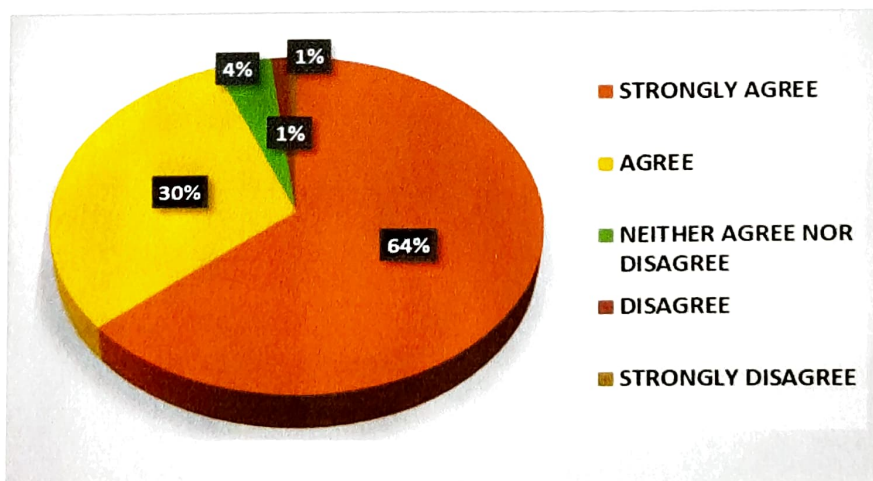
11. Sports and Canteen infrastructure are good.

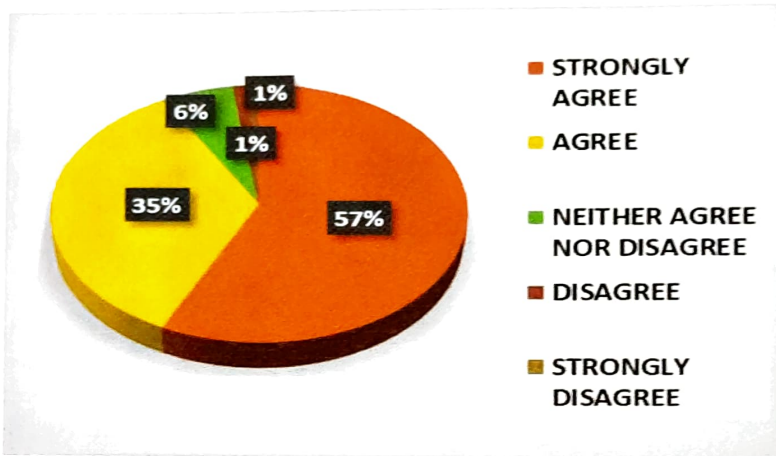
12. The college gives Importance to co-curricular and extracurricular activities

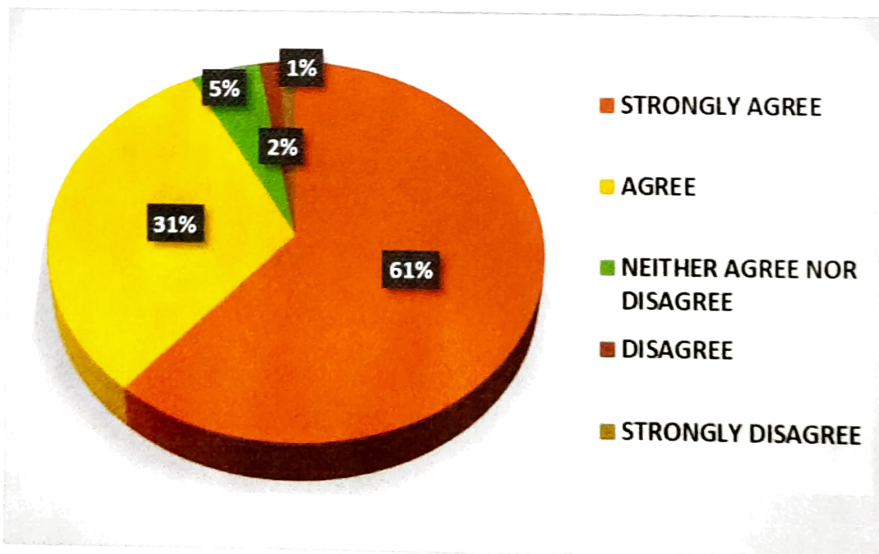

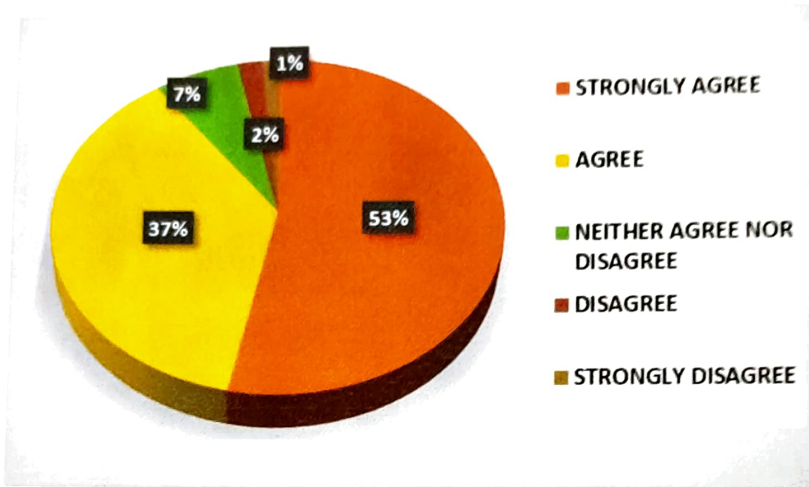
14. Toilets / Washrooms are clean and properly maintained.

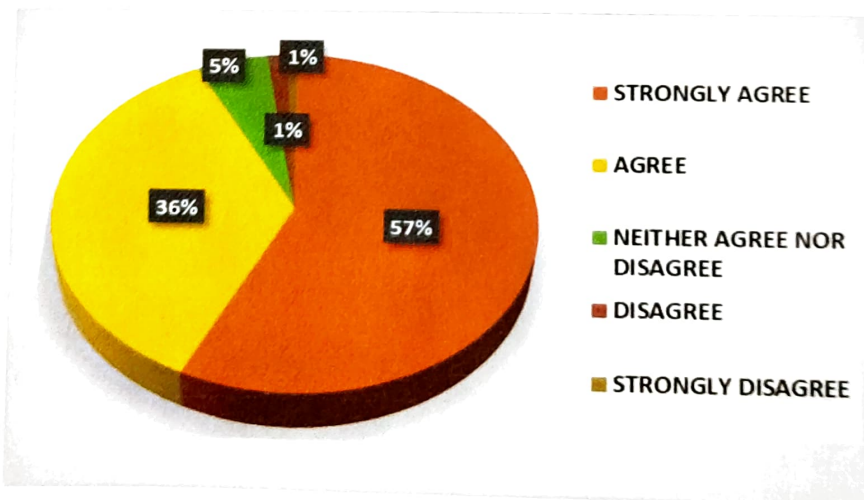
15. The college's administrative offices are efficient and student friendly.

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Analysis of Teachers' Feedback 2022-23

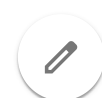
1. Teachers' feedback shows that 86% of the teachers believe that the college is able to attract meritorious students towards enrolment. To attract meritorious students apart from the different Government scholarships the management of the B.E.S. college also awards a meritorious student scholarship. In addition to this, 99% of the teachers trust that student centric resources are available in the college and classworks are taking place as per the schedule. Moreover, 96% of the respondents think that the college provides sufficient teaching facilities with relevant infrastructure to conduct the classes effectively.
2. As per the teachers' feedback, around 94% of the teachers are utilizing college library resources intensively. All the teachers are also updating their knowledge base in a timely manner.
3. The college library is quite resource intensive and 96% of the respondents have expressed that the college library is managed effectively with convenient as well as easy access.
4. 13% of the respondents felt that academic members should be encouraged more to carry out research activities. Faculty members have indicated that lack of time for research, incorporation of international collaboration and funding, involvement of senior and expert researchers into the research cell could be introduced to facilitate a promising and effective research environment.
5. All the faculty members appreciated the well-maintained buildings and furniture. The water service and safe drinking facilities were also appreciated by 97% faculty members. However, the laboratory equipment can further be improved as suggested by 9% of the respondents. 19% faculty members also expressed their concerns regarding the sufficiency of toilets present in the college.
6. Around 93% teachers agree that the MOUs entered by colleges enhance the scope for mutual cooperation with institutions of repute. The working strategy employed by the IQAC to promote quality of the institution is much appreciated by 94% of the faculty members.
7. Around 95% of the respondents expressed their satisfaction towards the administration for putting efforts for the development of the institution. There are, however, some concerns regarding internet facility, administration accessibility and freedom of expression which the college plans to address in the near future.

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Recommendations from the IQAC to the Governing Body based on stakeholders' feedback 2022-23

1. The college may consider refurbishing the Research Cell so that new ideas for encouraging research and publication among faculty members may be initiated. The cell may consider taking specific feedback from faculty regarding the issues faced in carrying out research.
2. The college may consider a proposal for creating differentiated time-tables for theory based subjects and practical based subjects – particularly in the Arts and Science sections.
3. The college may consider reconstituting many of the college committees so that fresh initiatives may be introduced and newer ventures may be explored by these committees.
4. The college may consider designing a new seminar hall that is not only wi-fi enabled, but has enough laptop charging stations so that around 40-50 participants can attend classes, workshops, conferences, etc. with their own laptops
5. The college may consider creating a two-way portal on the college website for parents. The portal may not only be used for posting important notices but may also be used by parents to upload their queries directed to the respective departments of their wards and/or the college.
6. The college may consider introducing a new LMS for an integrated, centralized and streamlined education and administration delivery system.
7. The college may consider upgrading the Alumni portal on the college website.
8. The college may consider designating separate WCs for male and female faculty members and staff on each floor.
